SUNDAY EPISTLE: 1 Corinthians 15: 1-10

Brethren: I make known unto you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you have received, and wherein you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast after what manner I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all, which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures; and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures; and that He was seen by Cephas, and after that by the eleven. Then was He seen by more than five hundred brethren at once; of whom many remain until this present, and some are fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James then by all the apostles. And last of all He was seen also by me, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God; but by the grace of God I am what I am; and His grace in me hath not been void.

SUNDAY GOSPEL: St. Mark 7: 31-37

At that time, Jesus going out of the coasts of Tyre, came by Sidon to the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis. And they bring to Him one deaf and dumb, and they besought Him that He would lay His hand upon him. And taking him from the multitude apart, He put His fingers into his ears, and spitting, He touched his tongue; and looking up to heaven, He groaned and said to him: Ephphetha, which is, Be thou opened: and immediately his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke right. And He charged them that they should tell no man: but the more He charged them so much the more a great deal did they publish it; and so much the more did they wonder, saying: He hath done all things well; He hath made both the deaf to hear and the dumb to speak.

❖ **How to Receive Communion:** When you receive Communion please tilt your head back, close your eyes, and stick your tongue out enough for Father to place the Eucharist on it without fear of dropping It.

❖ **Dominican Republic Trip:** Since many have wondered why I spent almost 2 weeks in the Dominican Republic, I thought it opportune to explain somewhat the purpose of the trip and why I decided to go this year. First of all, the DR Mission trip is part of the broader St Francis Xavier mission trips run by the FSSP in various countries, including Peru, Dominican Republic, and Mexico. One of the purposes of these mission trips is to give actual material and spiritual aid to various poor Catholic communities in these countries, some of which have very little regular contact with Catholic priests. The other purpose is for the sake of the spiritual formation and benefit of the American youth and young adult missionaries. The poverty experienced in these other countries is good for the young missionaries to see and to experience for themselves. In the words of a missionary pastor, the idea is not that the American missionaries “appreciate their own higher standard of living”, but rather, that they acquire a real love of poverty and learn to appreciate the poverty of Christ, especially as He empties Himself in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar. At first, I reluctantly agreed to go on this trip since there were no priests committed to going to the DR for several months. Afterwards, I was glad that I was able to make a small contribution, especially in the offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for the missionaries and the local people in various villages. I hope to have the privilege to serve on this mission trip again and I hope that other youth from Mater Misericordiae will consider going next year.
