◊ **Note from the Pastor:** How joyous it is for me to once again offer the solemn Holy Week liturgies for you. It is most joyous because last year we were not able to offer the liturgies publicly. For many of you this will also be the first time to experience such a treasure of our Church. I'm excited for you. I highly encourage your attendance most especially during the Triduum (Th-Sat). We will do our best this week to make the appropriate arrangements to maximize space and comfortability but most likely it will be crowded. Regardless, do come and accompany Our Lord through His passion that you might have a greater share in His glorious resurrection come Easter Sunday. We priests will keep you in our prayers this grace-filled week and I ask for your prayers for us, most especially on Holy Thursday. God reward you.

◊ **Pray for our Parish Vocations:** Please pray for our men: Fr. Caleb Insko, FSSP; Fr. Martin Rangel Garcia, FSSP; and Fr. Richard Wallace, FSSP; and Rev. Mr. Elijah Mundattuchundayil. Pray for Sr. Mary Thomas, O. Praem.

◊ **Low Mass Responses:** It is not customary at Mater Misericordiae for the faithful to make any spoken responses during the Mass. Please allow the altar servers alone to make the responses.

◊ **Passiontide:** During Passiontide, the altar crucifix and statues are veiled, the psalm *Judica me* is not said at the Prayers at the Foot of the Altar, and the doxology (*Gloria Patri*) is omitted from the *Asperges*, *Introit*, and *Lavabo*.

◊ **Liturgical Note for Lent:** *Alleluia is omitted until Holy Saturday. Until Holy Week, the seasonal Marian antiphon is Ave Regina Caelorum. Although there is no congregational singing this year, a recording of this chant is available on the music page of the parish website for anyone who wishes to learn it. During Lent, the organ may be played at Mass only to accompany singing, except on the fourth (Laetare) Sunday and feasts (De musica sacra, 1958, nos. 81-83).*

◊ **Current Laws of Fasting and Abstinence:** Those 14 and older are required to abstain from flesh meat during Ash Wednesday and every Friday of Lent. All those aged 15-59 inclusive are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is eating one full meal and two smaller meals which when combined do not equal the full meal. All of the Faithful are required to do penance every day of Lent, excluding Sundays.

◊ **Welcome:** Rev. Mr. Ramirez will be at our parish from March 26th until April 7th to partake in the celebration of our Holy Week festivities. Please be sure to give him a warm welcome and a thank you when you see him. By the grace of God, he will be ordained a priest next year. Please pray for him.

◊ **Congregational Singing:** We will resume normal congregational singing at all High Masses beginning with the Easter Vigil. Everyone is encouraged to join in the chanted responses such as "Et cum spiritu tuo" and "Amen." For hymns and the other parts of the Mass, the usual cues will be in place: page numbers on the hymn board and in the bulletin, and louder organ accompaniment. At the Sunday 8:00 AM Mass, you are invited to sing the closing Marian antiphon. Recordings of the congregational chants are available on the music page of the parish website. As a health precaution, there will be no singing at the 12:30 p.m. "masked" Mass.

◊ **Tenebrae:** Matins & Lauds will be sung Holy Saturday, April 3rd, at 6:00 AM. A booklet with an English translation will be provided for the congregation.

◊ **Stations of the Cross:** We invite you for the last Friday of this Lent at 6:00 PM in the church to join us as we reflect on the Passion of Our Lord with Stations of the Cross. A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who recite the "Prayer Before a Crucifix," every Friday during Lent.

◊ **Update on Mass Intentions:** We are unable to accept any Mass intentions at this time. Please be patient as we wait for our 2022 book. We will also no longer be accepting Mass Intentions for Fr. Valenzuela. Any Mass stipends received will be returned. Thank you for your understanding!
