◊ Important Sunday Mass Changes:

The 6:30 AM Sunday Mass on June 6th is canceled. We will have the Eucharistic procession visiting our parish, led by Bishop Olmsted, on this date instead. Please see the announcement for roses on the next page for more information and how to keep updated on this event.

The 10:30 AM Sunday High Mass on June 6th has been changed to 10 AM, and it is closed to the general public. This Mass will only for the children receiving their First Holy Communion and their families.

◊ **Note from the Pastor:** We have much to be thankful for, especially most recently here at the parish. The Lord continues to bless our community, as I learned this past week that our Deacon; Rev. Mr. Elijah Mundattuchundayil will be ordained to the priesthood on October 30th of this year (2021)! This is great news as there was possibility that he may have to wait a year, which is torture for a transitional deacon to wait so long for the priesthood. I know that Deacon Mundattuchundayil is overjoyed to receive this news as well as many of us. I am hoping that many of you will make the journey to Nebraska to witness his ordination. It is one of the most joyful days in the life of the Church (the day of priestly ordinations) and a ceremony which should be witnessed by all Catholic faithful. He will be the fourth man from our parish to be ordained a priest. Please mark this date on your calendar. I hope to celebrate with many of you as well as our soon to be Fr. Mundattuchundayil in Nebraska this fall.

◊ **High Mass Responses:** At all High Masses, the congregation is invited and encouraged to join in the chanted responses such as "Et cum spiritu tuo" and "Amen," as well as hymns and other parts of the Mass as announced on the hymn board and in the bulletin. Some chants are normally sung in alternation between the schola and congregation; please do not join in the a cappella parts, which should be sung by the schola alone. The congregation also sings the seasonal Marian antiphon after the 8 AM Sunday Mass.

◊ **Low Mass Responses:** It is not customary at Mater Misericordiae for the faithful to make any spoken responses during the Mass. Please allow the altar servers alone to make the responses.

◊ **Communion:** Please remember that when you are receiving Communion, you must kneel if you are able, tilt your head back slightly, close your eyes, and extend your tongue. You do not say "Amen" afterwards.
