## COLLECT

### SUNDAY EPISTLE: *Galatians 5. 25-26; 6. 1-10*

Brethren: If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be made desirous of vainglory, provoking one another, envying one another. Brethren, and if a man be overtaken in any fault, you, who are spiritual, instruct such a one in the spirit of meekness, considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so you shall fulfil the law of Christ. For if any man think himself to be something, whereas he is nothing, he deceiveth himself. But let everyone prove his own work, and so he shall have glory in himself only, and not in another. For every one shall bear his own burden. And let him that is instructed in the word, communicate to him that instructeth him, in all good things. Be not deceived: God is not mocked; for what things a man shall sow, those also shall he reap. For he that soweth in his flesh, of the flesh also shall reap corruption: but he that soweth in the spirit, of the spirit shall reap life everlasting. And in doing good, let us not fail; for in due time we shall reap, not failing. Therefore, whilst we have time, let us work good to all men, but especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

### SUNDAY GOSPEL: *Luke 7. 11-16*

At that time, Jesus went into a city called Naim; and there went with Him His disciples, and a great multitude. And when He came nigh to the city, behold a dead man was carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow, and a great multitude of the city were with her. And when the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her, and said to her: Weep not. And He came near and touched the bier. And they that carried it stood still. And He said: Young man, I say to thee, Arise: and he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And He delivered him to his mother. And there came a fear on them all: and they glorified God, saying: A great prophet is risen up amongst us, and God hath visited His people.

◊ **Note from the Pastor:** It is a joy for me to preach every day as it affords me the opportunity to learn about the saint of the day and the edifying life that he or she lived. I was quite fascinated, most recently, by the life of St. Joseph Calasanctius, whose feast day we celebrated on August 27, for all the trials and sufferings he had to undergo in order to provide Catholic education to poor children. In one of his writings, he compared children to twigs of plants which are easily influenced and manipulated by outside forces. However, he said that the greatest support we can provide "to protect the young from evil but also to rouse them and attract them more easily and gently to the performance of good works" is through a "study of the Catechism." Then, he says, when the children are formed in the teachings of their faith and "if they are allowed to grow strong, we know well that the possibility of one day bending them, diminishes greatly and is sometimes utterly lost."
