SUNDAY EPISTLE: *Acts. 4: 8-12*

NOTE FROM THE PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR

Upon entering the houses that are to be blessed for the Epiphany, the priest says "From the east came the Magi to Bethlehem to adore the Lord; and opening their treasures they offered precious gifts: gold for the great King, incense for the true God, and myrrh in symbol of His burial." Unfortunately, the priests of Mater Misericordiae will not be coming from the east, nor the west, nor from any directions to bless your homes this year. The other two priests will be away on vacation which will leave me alone to cover all the responsibilities of the parish, but I do hope that you will bless your own houses with the chalk and the epiphany holy water provided for you this coming Thursday.

There are two masses that day so please come to mass and pick up some chalk and Epiphany water. We will also provide instructions on how to bless your home and the beautiful formula that one uses to write over your exterior doors with the blessed chalk. It is a wonderful tradition to bless your home at the beginning of the year to start the year right and the extra exorcisms which are prayed over the water by the priest makes it even more potent against the attacks of the devil. In the same way that Christ welcomed the three wise men into his house, so let us welcome Christ into our homes by this solemn Epiphany blessing.

Al entrar la casa que sera bendecida para la Epifania, el sacerdote dice, "Del este vinieron los magos a Belen para adorar al Senor, y al abrir los tesoros le ofrecieron regalos preciosos: oro para el gran Rey, incienso para el verdadero Dios, y mirra para simbolizar su entierro." Desafortunadamente, los sacerdotes de Mater Misericordiae no vendrán del este, ni del oeste, y de ninguna dirección para bendecir sus hogares este año. Los otros dos sacerdotes estarán de vacaciones, dejándome sólo para atender todas las responsabilidades de la parroquia. Aun así, espero que bendigan sus propias casas con el giz y el agua bendecida de Epifanía que les vamos a tener este Jueves.

Habrán dos misas ese día así que por favor vengan y recogan un giz con agua de Epifanía. También les daremos instrucciones de cómo bendecir su casa y la bella fórmula que se usa para escribir sobre el exterior de las puertas con el giz bendecido. Bendecir tu hogar es una maravillosa tradición al principio del año para empezar bien el año, y los exorcismos adicionales que los sacerdotes rezan sobre el agua lo hacen aún más potente contra los ataques del demonio. De la misma manera que Cristo invitó a los tres reyes magos a su casa, también nosotros démosle la bienvenida a Cristo, dentro de nuestros hogares con esta bendición solemne de Epifanía.

◊ **Baptisms:** If you are a registered parishioner and are looking to have your child(ren) baptized, please contact Mrs. Valerie Villa in the parish office for the requirements. We recommend doing this **two months in advance** from the babies due date.

◊ **Sick Calls:** Our priests are able to visit the sick who wish to receive Sacraments. If you are a registered parishioner, please contact Mrs. Michelle Rodriguez by calling the parish office or by email at office@phoenixlatinmass.org to schedule an appointment.

◊ **Funerals:** Please have the **funeral home** contact Mrs. Michelle Rodriguez in the parish office to assist with funeral arrangement requests for registered parishioners.

◊ **Silence:** Please maintain silence in the Church, vestibule and hall **before, during and after** Mass.

◊ **Communion:** Please remember that when you are receiving Communion, you must kneel if you are able, tilt your head back slightly, close your eyes, and extend your tongue. You do not say "Amen" afterwards.

◊ **Low Mass Responses:** It is not customary at Mater Misericordiae and St. Edward's for the faithful to make any spoken responses during the Mass. Please allow the altar servers alone to make the responses.

◊ **Save the Date:** We will be removing the Christmas decorations from both Churches on Saturday, January 29th from 9 AM—noon. Please email the office at office@phoenixlatinmass.org to RSVP.

ANUNCIOS

◊ **¿Quiénes somos?:** La parroquia de Mater Misericordiae es un apostolado de la Fraternidad Sacerdotal de San Pedro (FSSP), que es una Sociedad de Vida Apostólica de Derecho Pontificio, erigida canónicamente por el Papa San Juan Pablo II en 1988. El carisma y la misión particular de la FSSP es ofrecer la Sagrada Liturgia, incluida la Santa Misa y el oficio divino, así como los sacramentos, en toda su solemnidad tradicional, según los libros litúrgicos latinos de 1962. Bienvenidos a nuestra parroquia!

◊ **Comunión:** Recuerden que al recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía, deben arrodillarse si es posible, inclinar la cabeza hacia atrás solo un poco, cerrar los ojos, y extender la lengua. No se dice "Amen" después de recibir.

◊ **Silencio:** Favor de mantener silencio dentro de la Iglesia, vestíbulo, y el pasillo **antes, durante, y después** de Misa.

◊ **Respuestas durante Misa Lecta:** En Mater Misericordiae y San Eduardo no se acostumbra que los fieles respondan en voz alta. Dejen que solo los monaguillos respondan.
