SUNDAY EPISTLE: *Romans 13: 8-10*

NOTE FROM THE PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR

A couple Sunday's ago, we had as the gospel reading the wedding feast of Cana and in that passage we saw how powerful the intercession of the Heavenly Mother is with her Divine Son. It should not be a surprise therefore, that in this time of grave uncertainty regarding the Latin Mass and the FSSP, our Superior General has asked us to consecrate our Fraternity and work to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The formal consecration will take place on the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11th, and will be preceded by a novena of preparatory prayers beginning February 2nd to the 10th. That means that in lieu of the Leonine prayers said after low mass, we will pray a decade of the rosary and the Memorare during this time. I encourage you all to come to mass as often as possible during the novena and continue to pray for us and the preservation of the Latin Mass. May Our Lady continue to protect us and may God reward you.

Anteriormente tuvimos el Evangelio de las bodas de Caná y en ese relato vemos cuan poderosa es la intercesión de nuestra madre celestial con su Hijo Divino. Entonces pues, no nos debería sorprender que en este tiempo de incertidumbre con respecto a la Misa en Latín y la FSSP, que nuestro Superior General nos haiga pedido que consagremos nuestra fraternidad y trabajo al Inmaculado Corazón de María. La consagración formal tomará plazo el día de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes el día 11 de Febrero y será precedida por una novena de rezos preparatorios empezando el 2 de Febrero y seguirá hasta el día 10. Esto quiere decir que en vez de las oraciones Leoninas dichas después de la Misa Rezada, rezaremos una década del rosario y el Memorare (Acordaos) durante estos días de la novena. Los animo a todos ustedes que vengan a Misa lo más posible durante esta novena y que sigan rezando por nosotros y por la preservación de la Misa Tridentina. Que Nuestra Señora nos proteja y que Dios se los pague.

◊ **Welcome:** Our FSSP Provincial, Fr. William Lawrence, is visiting January 31st-February 4th. He may be offering public Masses while here. Please extend him a warm Phoenix welcome if you see him and keep him in your prayers.

◊ **Announcement:** On January 14th, the Diocese released a statement from Bishop Olmsted asking the faithful to unite through prayer and sacrifice instead of participating in any type of protest at the venue of the upcoming "SatanCon". While we know this disheartens and saddens many of you, Fr. Passo asks that parishioners refrain from going to the venue on February 11th-13th. He will address this further in the upcoming days.

◊ **Addition of 8am Mass:** Beginning February, an additional Mass will be added to the schedule on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. Please see the front of the bulletin for the location of each of these Masses.

◊ **FSSP Calendars:** There are a limited number of calendars available at the Mater Parish Office. They are \$10 each and will be available until we run out. Stop by the Parish office during office hours and purchase a 2022 calendar!

◊ **Flocknote:** Sign up for our parish's Flocknote through our website to receive all the latest news and schedule updates.

◊ **Coffee & Doughnuts at St. Edward!:** The Knights of Columbus will be sponsoring Coffee and Doughnuts at **St. Edward** under the pavilion after the 9:00 AM Mass featuring premium Lifeboat Colombian coffee. Your generous donations are appreciated, but all are welcome. Please join us!

◊ **Helpers of the Immaculate Heart:** Our parish girls' group will be selling candles for Candlemas. Purchase candles **today, at Mater Misericordiae on January 30th**, before and after both Masses. Candles are \$5 a pair or 5 pairs for \$20.

◊ **Men Needed to Sing:** The choir has immediate openings for tenor and bass voices. New members must be able to match pitch ("carry a tune"), blend well with other voices, and commit to rehearsals 7-8:45PM every Tuesday. A brief placement audition is required for the mixed choir. The average time commitment is about four hours per week. The men's schola also has openings. The average commitment for the schola is about six hours per week. Men who participate in both choirs should be available for eight hours per week on average. Like last year, a special "mega schola" will sing for the Easter Triduum, including men from both choirs, former members, and other parishioners. Rehearsals will take place after Sunday High Mass at **Mater Misericordiae**, 11AM-1PM March 13, 20, and 27, Saturday, April 9, 9-11AM, and about ten hours of rehearsals and services during Holy Week. ◊ **Extra Precautions:** Because a satanic conference will be held in Scottsdale from February 11th-13th, there will be extra precautions from now until the event, especially at the time of distribution of the Holy Eucharist. After receiving, there is no reason to leave the church and we ask that you return to your seat for the remainder of the Mass. Thank you for your cooperation!

◊ **Blessing of Candles:** The Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also known as Candlemas, will be on **Wednesday, February 2nd. St. Edward** will be open all day for parishioners to drop off their candles. The day will begin with confessions at 7:30AM, followed by Mass at 8AM, and will end with the blessing of the candles, a procession outside and then High Mass at 6:30PM. Please bring your candles to **St. Edward** no later than 6PM so they can be blessed along with the liturgical candles.

◊ **St. Blaise & Blessing of the Throats:** Because we have the privilege and honor of having a first class relic of St. Blaise to grace our altar, we celebrate the feast of St. Blaise on **Thursday, February 3rd.** St. Blaise was a physician and then a bishop in Armenia during the fourth century. He is best known for having miraculously cured a boy on the verge of death from choking on a fishbone and has been invoked by those afflicted with illnesses of the throat. Masses will be at **6:30AM at St. Edward** and at **12PM at Mater Misericordiae.** A blessing will be given by touching the throat of each person with two candles that have been blessed on the feast of Candlemas and then joined together in the form of a cross. There will also be an opportunity for veneration of the relic. Please come to Mass on this day!

◊ **Day of Prayer & Fasting:** On Friday, February 4th, we will be having a special day of prayer and fasting as a parish in thanksgiving to Bishop Olmsted, for his generosity towards our community, as well as for the incoming new bishop. There will be adoration and benediction and we would like parishioners to sign-up as adorers. The day will begin with 6:30AM Mass and conclude with 6:30PM High Mass. All activities will take place at **St. Edward.** A Flocknote will be sent out soon with available times for adoration. Please make sure you are signed up to receive Flocknotes.

◊ **Ladies Group:** There will be an informational meeting for the re-establishment of our ladies group, led by Fr. Portzer on February 12th, at 9AM in the church hall at **Mater Misericordiae.** Please attend if interested!
