## COLLECT

Graciously hear, we beseech Thee, O Lord, the prayers of Thy people, that we who are justly afflicted for our sins, may be mercifully delivered by Thy goodness, for the glory of Thy name. Through our Lord.

## SUNDAY EPISTLE: 1 *Corinthians* 9. 24-27

Brethren: Know you not that they that run in the race, all run indeed, but one receiveth the prize? So run that you may obtain. And every one that striveth for the mastery refraineth himself from all things: and they indeed that they may receive a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible one. I therefore so run, not as at an uncertainty; I so fight, not as one beating the air: but I chastise my body, and bring it into subjection, lest perhaps when I have preached to others, I myself should become a castaway. For I would not have you ignorant, brethren, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea, and all in Moses were baptized, in the cloud and in the sea: and did all eat the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink: (and they drank of the spiritual rock that followed them: and the rock was Christ). But with most of them God was not well pleased.

## SUNDAY GOSPEL: *Matthew* 20. 1-16

At that time Jesus spoke to His disciples this parable: The kingdom of heaven is like to a householder who went out early in the morning to hire labourers into his vineyard. And having agreed with the labourers for a penny a day, he sent them into his vineyard. And going out about the third hour, he saw others standing in the marketplace idle, and he said to them: Go you also into my vineyard, and I will give you what shall be just. And they went their way. And again he went out about the sixth and the ninth hour: and did in like manner. But about the eleventh hour he went out and found others standing, and he saith to them: Why stand you here all the day idle? They say to him: Because no man hath hired us. He saith to them: Go you also into my vineyard. And when evening was come, the lord of the vineyard saith to his steward: Call the labourers and pay them their hire, beginning from the last even to the first. When therefore they were come that came about the eleventh hour, they received every man a penny. But when the first also came, they thought that they should receive more: and they also received every man a penny. And receiving it they murmured against the master of the house, saying: These last have worked but one hour, and thou hast made them equal to us that have borne the burden of the day and the heats. But he answering said to one of them: Friend, I do thee no wrong: didst thou not agree with me for a penny? Take what is thine and go thy way: I will also give to this last even as to thee. Or, is it not lawful for me to do what I will? Is thy eye evil, because I am good? So shall the last be first, and the first last. For many are called, but few chosen.

## DOMINGO EPÍSTOLA: 1 *Corintios*. 9. 24-27

Hermanos: ¿No sabéis que los atletas que corren en el estadio, todos corren, mas uno solo alcanza el premio? Corred de manera que lo ganéis. Todo el que lucha en la arena de todo se abstiene: y aquellos ciertamente por recibir una corona corruptible; mas nosotros, incorruptible. Pues yo corro no como a la ventura: peleo, no como quien azota al viento; antes castigo mi cuerpo y lo reduzco a servi-dumbre, para que no suceda que habiendo predicado a los demás, venga yo a ser reprobado. Porque no quiero, hermanos, que ignoréis que nuestros padres estuvieron todos bajo la nube en el desierto, y todos pasaron el mar Rojo y todos, dirigidos por Moisés fueron bautizados en la nube y en el mar : y todos comieron un mismo manjar espiritual y todos bebieron la misma bebida espiritual (porque bebían de una piedra misteriosa que los iba siguiendo: y la piedra era Cristo); pero no muchos de ellos agradaron a Dios.

## DOMINGO EVANGELIO: *Mateo* 20. 1-16

En aquél tiempo: Dijo Jesús a sus discípulos esta parábola: Semejante es el reino de los cielos a un hombre, padre de familia, que salió muy de mañana a ajustar obreros para su viña. Y habiendo convenido con los obreros en darles un denario por día, los envió a su viña. Y saliendo, cerca de la hora tercia, vio otros en la plaza que estaban ociosos. Y les dijo: Id también vosotros a mi viña, y os daré lo que fuere justo. Y ellos se fueron. Volvió a salir cerca de la hora de sexta y de nona, e hizo lo mismo. Salió por fin cerca de la hora undécima, y vio otros que estaban allí, y les dijo: ¿Qué hacéis aquí todo el día ociosos? Y ellos le respondieron: Porque ninguno nos ha contratado. Díceles: Id también vosotros a mi viña. Y al venir la noche, dijo el dueño de la viña a su mayordomo: Llama a los obreros, y págales su jornal, comenzando por los últimos hasta los primeros. Cuando vinieron los que habían ido cerca de la hora undécima, recibieron cada cual su denario. Al llegar los primeros, creyeron que les darían más: pero no recibió sino un denario cada uno. Y al recibirlo murmuraban contra el padre de familia, diciendo: Estos últimos sólo han trabajado una hora, y los has igualado con nosotros, que hemos llevado el peso del día y del calor. Mas él dijo: Amigo, no te hago ningún agravio: ¿no conveniste conmigo en un denario? Toma lo que es tuyo y vete: pues quiero yo dar a este, bien que sea el último, tanto como a ti. ¿No me es lícito hacer de lo mío lo que quiera? ¿O será tu ojo malo, porque yo soy bueno? Así que los últimos serán los primeros, y los primeros, postreros. Porque muchos son los llamados, y pocos los escogidos.



## NOTES FROM THE PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR

Dear Faithful, I would like to institute a change regarding our First Friday schedule. Since my arrival we have had a High Mass at 6:30PM followed by an hour of adoration and benediction. However, two weeks ago we had a full day of adoration in honor of Bishop Olmsted at St. Edward and I was very pleased to see that every hour had at least five adorers in front of the Blessed Sacrament. We priests like the idea of leaving St. Edward open all day and allowing you the opportunity to spend some time in adoration and at your convenience. Therefore, from henceforth, we will no longer have an hour of adoration after the 6:30PM High Mass but rather a full day of adoration beginning after the 6:30AM Mass and leading up to the 6:30PM High Mass. Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and the singing of the Litany will take place at 6PM, right before mass. A flock note will be sent out each month so that you can volunteer for an hour and this will also allow us to ensure that we have enough adorers. If you did not come last month, please come in the following months and make reparation to the Sacred Heart by simply remaining in His presence.

Estimados Fieles, quisiera instituir un cambio con respecto al calendario del primer viernes. Desde que llegué hemos tenido misa a las 6:30PM, seguido por una hora de adoración eucarística, exposición y bendición. Sin embargo, hace dos semanas tuvimos un día entero de adoración en San Eduardo en honor al Obispo Olmsted y me dio mucho gusto al ver que hubo por lo menos cinco adoradores en frente del Santísimo cada hora. A nosotros los sacerdotes nos gusta la idea de poder dejar abierta las puertas de San Eduardo todo el día y permitirles pasar tiempo en adoración a su conveniencia. Por esta razón, de aquí en adelante, ya no tendremos una hora de adoración después de la misa Cantada de 6:30PM sino un día entero, empezando con la misa de 6:30AM y hasta la misa Cantada de 6:30PM. Exposición y bendición del Santísimo Sacramento y el canto de la letanía será antes de misa, a las 6PM. Un Flocknote será enviado cada mes para que se apunten de adoradores voluntarios y esto nos asegurará que tendremos suficientes adoradores. Si no vinieron el mes pasado, por favor vengan y hagan reparación al Sagrado Corazón con solo permanecer en Su presencia.
