COLLECT

O GOD, who seest that we put not our trust in anything that we do; mercifully grant that by the protection of the Doctor of the Gentiles we may be defended against all adversity. Through our Lord.

SUNDAY GOSPEL: *Luke 8. 4-15*

At that time, when a very great multitude was gathered together and hastened out of the cities unto Jesus, He spoke by a similitude: The sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the wayside, and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it. And other some fell upon a rock: and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it had no moisture. And other some fell among thorns, and the thorns growing up with it choked it. And other some fell upon good ground: and being sprung up yielded fruit a hundredfold. Saying these things, He cried out: He that hath ears to hear, let him hear. And His disciples asked Him what this parable might be. To whom He said: To you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God, but to the rest in parables: that seeing they may not see, and hearing may not understand. Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. And they by the wayside are they that hear: then the devil cometh and taketh the word out of their heart, lest believing they should be saved. Now they upon the rock are they who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no roots: for they believe for a while, and in time of temptation they fall away. And that which fell among thorns are they who have heard and, going their way, are choked with the cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and yield no fruit. But that on the good ground are they who in a good and perfect heart, hearing the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit in patience.

DOMINGO EVANGELIO: *Lucas 8. 4-15*

En aquel tiempo se reunía mucha gente en torno a Jesús y al pasar por los pueblos, otros se iban añadiendo. Entonces les dijo esta parábola: Salió el sembrador a sembrar su semilla. Al sembrarla, algo cayó al borde del camino, lo pisaron, y los pájaros del cielo se lo comieron. Otro poco cayó en terreno pedregoso, y al crecer se secó por falta de humedad. Otro poco cayó entre zarzas, y las zarzas, creciendo al mismo tiempo, lo ahogaron. El resto cayó en tierra buena, y al crecer dio fruto al ciento por uno. Dicho esto, exclamó: El que tenga oídos para oír, que oiga. Entonces le preguntaron sus discípulos: ¿Qué significa esta parábola? Y Él les respondió: A vosotros se os ha concedido conocer los misterios del Reino de Dios; a los demás, en parábolas, para que viendo no vean y oyendo no entiendan. El sentido de la parábola es éste: La semilla es la Palabra de Dios. Los del borde del camino son los que escuchan, pero luego viene el diablo y se lleva la Palabra de sus corazones, para que no crean y se salven. Los del terreno pedregoso son los que, al escucharla, reciben la Palabra con alegría, pero no tienen raíz; son los que por el momento creen, pero en el momento de la prueba fallan. Lo que cayó entre las zarzas son los que escuchan, pero con los afanes y riquezas y placeres de la vida, se van ahogando y no maduran. Lo de la tierra buena son los que con un corazón noble y bueno escuchan la Palabra, la guardan y perseveran hasta dar fruto.

NOTE FROM THE PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR

We read in Second Kings that the bones of the holy prophet Elisha brought a dead man to life and in Acts we read that the handkerchiefs of St. Paul were carried to the sick so that they might be cured of their diseases. The Smyrneans wrote after St. Polycarp's martyrdom (who was burned at the stake in 156 AD) "We took up his bones, which are more valuable than precious stones and finer than refined gold and laid them in a suitable place." The Gospel itself testifies to the great care given by Joseph of Arimathea, Nicodemos, and Mary Magdalene to honor and reverence the remains of Christ in the tomb. Such has been the custom, since the Old Testament, of the veneration of relics and the material objects left behind by the saints.

Therefore, I ask for your prayers for two parishioners who have generously given up their 1st class relics so that they might adorn our main altar and be venerated at St. Edwards. Relics are treasures of the Church and thanks to them we will now have St. Ignatius of Loyola and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton joining the other two relics currently on the altar (St. Boniface and St. Blaise). May God reward them!

Leemos en el Segundo libro de Los Reyes que los huesos del santo profeta Eliseo resucitan a un hombre y leemos tambien en Hechos de los Apóstoles que los pañuelos de San Pablo se usaron para sanar a los enfermos. Después del martirio de Policarpo (quien fue quemado en la hoguera en el año 156 AD), los Esmirniotas escribieron, "Nos llevamos sus huesos que son mas valiosos que las piedras preciosas y más finas que oro fino y las reposamos en un lugar apropiado." El evangelio en sí mismo es testigo del gran cuidado que tuvieron por José de Arimatea, Nicodemo, y María Magdalena al honrar y reverenciar los restos de Cristo en la tumba. Así pues ha sido la costumbre desde el Antiguo Testamento la veneración de las reliquias y los objetos materiales heredados por los santos.

Les pido una oración por dos feligreses que tan generosamente donaron sus reliquias de primera clase para adornar a nuestro altar en San Eduardo y para que la reliquia sea venerada. Las reliquias son tesoros de la iglesia y gracias a ellos tendremos a San Ignacio de Loyola y a Santa Elizabeth Ann Seton unidos con las otras dos reliquias de San Bonifacio y San Blas que ya están sobre el altar. ¡Qué Dios los bendiga!
