SUNDAY GOSPEL: Luke 18. 31-43

At that time Jesus took unto Him the twelve and said to them: Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things shall be accomplished which were written by the Prophets concerning the Son of Man. For He shall be delivered to the Gentiles, and shall be mocked and scourged and spit upon: and after they have scourged Him, they will put Him to death, and the third day He shall rise again. And they understood none of these things, and this word was hid from them, and they understood not the things that were said. Now it came to pass, when He drew nigh to Jericho, that a certain blind man sat by the wayside, begging. And when he heard the multitude passing by, he asked what this meant. And they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by. And he cried out, saying: Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me. And they that went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace. But he cried out much more: Son of David, have mercy on me. And Jesus standing, commanded him to be brought unto him. And immediately he saw and followed Him glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.

NOTE FROM THE PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR

The Venerable Fulton Sheen says, "Unless there is a Good Friday in your life, there can be no Easter Sunday." And the beautiful St. Rose of Lima once said, "Apart from the cross, there is no other ladder by which we may get to heaven."

Let us ambitiously enter this Lenten season realizing that the glories of heaven are always preceded by suffering and the cross. Added to the Lenten practices/sacrifices that you presumably have chosen on your own, the Church requires you to both fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat. Fasting permits only one full meal and two snacks which when combined are less than one full meal. Fasting is applicable to everyone in good health and between the ages of (18-59) and abstinence is applicable under the same conditions, for those who have completed their 14th birthday.

Finally, I remind you of the great words of St. Paul to the Corinthians "If I were to have the faith to move mountains...or deliver my body to be burned but have not charity, it profited me nothing." Especially in our Lenten practices may they be united with the virtue of charity. God bless you.

El Venerable Fulton Sheen dijo que, si no hay un Viernes Santo en tu vida, no puede haber Domingo de Pascua. Incluso, la bella Santa Rosa de Lima una vez dijo, "Apartados de la cruz, no hay ninguna otra escalera por la cual podemos llegar al cielo."

Entremos ambiciosamente en esta temporada de cuaresma dándonos cuenta de que las glorias del cielo siempre son precedidas por el sufrimiento en la cruz. Además de a las prácticas y sacrificios que presumiblemente han escogido, la Iglesia requiere que los fieles ayunen y se abstengan de carne durante el Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo. Adicionalmente, todos los viernes de Cuaresma son días de abstinencia de carne. Al ayunar, solo se permite una sola comida completa y dos colaciones que al ser combinadas sean menos que una comida completa. El ayuno es para a todos aquellos que tengan buen estado de salud, entre las edades de 18 a 59 años. La abstinencia es obligatoria bajo las mismas condiciones para todos los que han cumplido los 14 años.

Finalmente, les recuerdo las grandes palabras de San Pablo a los Corintios, "Aunque tuviera plenitud de fe como para trasladar montañas, si no tengo caridad, nada soy. Aunque repartiera todos mis bienes, y entregara mi cuerpo a las llamas, si no tengo caridad, nada me aprovecha." Que nuestras practicas Cuaresmales sean unidas con la virtud de caridad. Dios los bendiga.

Decree of Pope Francis Concerning the FSSP

Decree of Pope Francis confirming the use of the 1962 liturgical books

[Original: Latin and Spanish]

The Holy Father Francis, grants to each and every member of the Society of Apostolic Life “Fraternity of Saint Peter”, founded on July 18, 1988 and declared of “Pontifical Right” by the Holy See, the faculty to celebrate the sacrifice of the Mass, and to carry out the sacraments and other sacred rites, as well as to fulfill the Divine Office, according to the typical editions of the liturgical books, namely the Missal, the Ritual, the Pontifical and the Roman Breviary, in force in the year 1962.

They may use this faculty in their own churches or oratories; otherwise it may only be used with the consent of the Ordinary of the place, except for the celebration of private Masses.

Without prejudice to what has been said above, the Holy Father suggests that, as far as possible, the provisions of the *motu proprio Traditionis Custodes* be taken into account as well.

Given in Rome, near St. Peter’s, on February 11, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes in the year 2022, the ninth year of my Pontificate.
