EPISTLE: 1 Thessalonians 4. 1-7

Brethren: We pray and beseech you in the Lord Jesus that, as you have received from us, now you ought to walk and to please God, so also you would walk, that you may abound the more. For you know what precepts I have given to you by the Lord Jesus. For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from fornication, that every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour; not in the passion of lust, like the Gentiles that know not God: and that no man overreach nor circumvent his brother in business: because the Lord is the avenger of all these things, as we have told you before and have testified. For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto sanctification: in Christ Jesus our Lord.

SUNDAY GOSPEL: Matthew 17. 1-9

At that time Jesus took Peter and James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into a high mountain apart: and He was transfigured before them. And his face did shine as the sun: and His garments became white as snow. And behold there appeared to them Moses and Elias talking with Him. And Peter answering, said to Jesus: Lord, it is good for us to be here: if Thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles, one for Thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias. And as he was yet speaking, behold a bright cloud overshadowed them. And lo, a voice out of the cloud, saying: This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased: hear ye Him. And the disciples hearing, fell upon their face and were very much afraid. And Jesus came and touched them, and said to them: Arise, and fear not. And they lifting up their eyes saw no one, but only Jesus. And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying: Tell the vision to no man till the Son of Man be risen from the dead.

EPISTOLA: 1 Tesalonicenses 4. 1-7

Hermanos: Os rogamos y exhortamos en nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que así como habéis aprendido de nosotros de qué manera habéis de portaros y agradar a Dios, así también sigáis para ir adelantando. Porque ya sabéis qué preceptos os he dado en nombre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Esta es la voluntad de Dios, a saber: vuestra santificación: que os abstengáis de la fornicación, y que sepa cada uno de vosotros que su propio cuerpo es un vaso de santificación y de honor, que no debe entregar a sus pasiones, como hacen los gentiles, que no conocen a Dios: y que nadie oprima, ni engañe en nada a su hermano: porque el Señor es vengador de todas estas cosas, como ya antes os lo hemos dicho y protestado. Porque no nos llamó Dios a la inmundicia, sino a la santidad, en Jesucristo, Señor nuestro.

DOMINGO EVANGELIO: Mateo 17. 1-19

En aquél tiempo: Tomó Jesús consigo a Pedro y a Santiago y a Juan su hermano, y los llevó aparte a un monte alto: y allí se transfiguró en su presencia, resplandeciendo su rostro como el sol, y quedando sus vestiduras blancas como la nieve. Y en esto se aparecieron Moisés y Elías, hablando con El. Tomó entonces Pedro la palabra y dijo a Jesús: Señor, bueno es que permanezcamos aquí: si quieres, hagamos aquí tres tiendas, una para Ti, otra para Moisés y otra para Elías. Estaba Pedro aún hablando, cuando vino una nube resplandeciente a cubrirlos. Y de pronto se oyó una voz desde la nube que decía: Este es mi Hijo muy amado, en quien tengo todas mis complacencias: escuchadle. Y al oír esta voz los discípulos cayeron sobre su rostro en tierra, y tuvieron grande miedo. Mas Jesús se acercó a ellos, y los tocó, y les dijo: Levantaos, y no temáis. Y alzando ellos sus ojos no vieron a nadie sino sólo a Jesús. Y al bajar ellos del monte, les mandó Jesús diciendo: No digáis a nadie lo que habéis visto, hasta que el Hijo del hombre haya resucitado de entre los muertos.
