EPISTLE: Ephesians 5. 1-9

Brethren: Be ye followers of God, as most dear children: and walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us and hath delivered Himself for us, an oblation and a sacrifice to God for an odour of sweetness. But fornication, and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not so much as be named among you, as becometh saints: or obscenity, or foolish talking, or scurrility, which is to no purpose: but rather giving of thanks. For know you this, and understand, that no fornicator, or unclean or covetous person, which is a serving of idols, hath inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the anger of God upon the children of unbelief. Be ye not therefore partakers with them. For you were heretofore darkness: but now light in the Lord. Walk then as children of the light: for the fruit of the light is in all goodness, and justice, and truth.

SUNDAY GOSPEL: Luke 11. 14-28

At that time Jesus was casting out a devil, and the same was dumb. And when He had cast out the devil, the dumb spoke, and the multitudes were in admiration at it. But some of them said: He casteth out devils by Beelzebub, the prince of devils. And others, tempting, asked of Him a sign from heaven. But He, seeing their thoughts, said to them: Every kingdom divided against itself shall be brought to desolation, and house upon house shall fall. And if Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because you say that through Beelzebub I cast out devils. Now if I cast out devils by Beelzebub, by whom do your children cast them out? Therefore, they shall be your judges. But if I by the finger of God cast out devils: doubtless the kingdom of God is come upon you. When a strong man armed keepeth his court, those things are in peace which he possesseth. But if a stronger than he come upon him and overcome him, he will take away all his armour wherein he trusted, and will distribute his spoils. He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with Me scattereth. When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through places without water, seeking rest: and not finding, he saith: I will return into my house whence I came out. And when he is come, he findeth it swept and garnished. Then he goeth and taketh with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and entering in they dwell there. And the last state of that man becomes worse than the first. And it came to pass, as He spoke these things, a certain woman from the crowd, lifting up her voice, said to Him: Blessed is the womb that bore Thee, and the paps that gave Thee suck. But He said: Yea, rather, blessed are they who hear the word of God, and keep it.

EPISTOLA: 1 Efesios 5. 1-9

Hermanos: Sed imitadores de Dios, como hijos muy amados. Vivid en el amor, como Cristo nos amó, y se ofreció a sí mismo a Dios por nosotros en oblación y hostia de olor suavísimo. Por tanto, la fornicación y toda clase de impureza, o avaricia, ni se nombre entre vosotros, cual conviene a los santos; ni palabras torpes y necias, ni truhanerías, ni bufonadas, lo cual desdice; sino, antes bien, acciones de gracias. Porque habéis de saber y entender que ningún fornicario, o impúdico, o avaro, lo cual viene a ser una idolatría, será heredero del reino de Cristo y Dios. Nadie os engañe con palabras vanas; pues por tales cosas vino la ira de Dios sobre los incrédulos. No queráis, por tanto, tener parte con ellos. Porque en otro tiempo erais tinieblas; mas ahora sois luz en el Señor. Andad como hijos de la luz, pues el fruto de la luz consiste en toda bondad, justicia y verdad.

DOMINGO EVANGELIO: Lucas 11. 14-28

En aquel tiempo: Estaba Jesús lanzando un demonio, el cual era mudo. Y, así que hubo lanzado al demonio, habló el mudo y se maravillaron las turbas. Mas algunos dijeron; Por arte de Belcebú, príncipe de los demonio, expulsa los demonios. Y otros, para tentarle, le pedían algún prodigio del cielo. Jesús, que veía sus pensamientos les dijo: Todo reino dividido en bandos quedará destruido, y caerá casa sobre casa. Si Satanás está también dividido contra sí mismo, ¿cómo subsistirá su reino? Pues decís que lanzo los demonios en virtud de Belcebú. Y si yo lanzo los demonios por virtud de Belcebú, vuestros hijos, ¿por virtud de quién los lanzan? Por tanto, ellos mismos serán vuestros jueces. Mas si con el dedo de Dios lanzo los demonios, ciertamente el reino de Dios ha llegado ya a vosotros. Cuando un valiente armado guarda la puerta de su casa, está seguro todo cuanto posee. Mas si, asaltándole otro más fuerte que él, le venciere, le quitará todas sus armas, en que confiaba, y repartirá sus despojos. El que no está conmigo, está contra mí, y el que no recoge conmigo, desparrama. Cuando el espíritu inmundo ha salido de un hombre, anda por lugares áridos buscando reposo; y, no hallándolo, se dice: Volveré a mi casa, de donde salí. Y, tornando a ella, la encuentra barrida y adornada. Entonces va y toma consigo otros siete espíritus peores que él, y, entrando en ella, moran allí; y así, el estado de este hombre viene a ser peor que el primero. Así hablaba, cuando una mujer de en medio del pueblo levantó la voz y exclamó: ¡Dichoso el vientre que te llevó y los pechos que te amantaron! Y él dijo: Dichosos más bien lo que oyen la palabra de Dios y la practican.
