SUNDAY GOSPEL AFTER THE BLESSING OF THE PALMS:**Matthew 21. 1-9**

At that time, when Jesus drew nigh to Jerusalem, and was come to Bethphage, unto Mount Olivet, then He sent two disciples, saying to them: Go ye into the village that is over against you, and immediately you shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her; loose them and bring them to Me; and if any man shall say anything to you, say ye that the Lord hath need of them; and forthwith he will let them go. Now all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: Tell ye the daughter of Sion: Behold thy King cometh to thee meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of her that is used to the yoke. And the disciples going did as Jesus commanded them. And they brought the ass and the colt, and laid their garments upon them, and made Him sit thereon. And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way, and others cut boughs from the trees, and strewed them in the way, and the multitudes that went before and that followed cried, saying: Hosanna to the Son of David; Blessed is He that cometh in the Name of the Lord.

EPISTLE FOR SUNDAY MASS: *Philippians 2. 5-11*

Brethren, let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus: who being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God; but emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant, being made in the likeness of men, and in habit found as a man. He humbled Himself, becoming obedient unto death, even to the death of the cross. For which cause God also hath exalted Him, and hath given Him a name which is above all names: (Here all genuflect) that in the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those that are in heaven, on earth, and under the earth: and that every tongue should confess that the Lord Jesus Christ is in the glory of God the Father.

EVANGELIO DOMINICAL DESPUES DE BENDICION DE PALMAS:**Mateo 21. 1-9**

En aquel tiempo: Acercándose Jesús a Jerusalén, luego que llegó a Betfagé, en el monte de los Olivos, envió a dos discípulos, diciéndoles: Id a esa aldea en frente de vosotros, y en seguida encontraréis una asna atada, y su pollino con ella; desatadlos y traédmelos; y si alguno os dijere algo, respondedle que los necesita el Señor, y al punto, os los dejará llevar. Todo esto sucedió en cumplimiento de lo que dijo el Profeta: Decid a la hija de Sión: Mira, que viene a ti tu Rey, lleno de mansedumbre, sentado sobre una asna, y su pollino, hijo de la que está acostumbrada al yugo. Fuéronse los discípulos, e hicieron lo que Jesús les había mandado. Trajeron el asna y el pollino, y los aparejaron con sus vestidos, y le hicieron sentar encima. Y una gran muchedumbre de gentes tendían por el camino sus vestidos y otros cortaban ramas de los árboles, y las esparcían por el camino. Y tanto las gentes que iban delante, como las que venían detrás, clamaban, diciendo: Hosanna al hijo de David. Bendito sea el que viene en nombre del Señor.

EPISTOLA PARA MISA DOMINICAL: *Filipenses 2. 5-11*

Hermanos: Tened entre vosotros los sentimientos propios de una vida en Cristo Jesús. Él, a pesar de su condición divina, no hizo alarde de su categoría de Dios; al contrario, se despojó de su rango, y tomó la condición de esclavo, pasando por uno de tantos. Y así, actuando como un hombre cualquiera, se rebajó hasta someterse a la muerte, y una muerte de cruz. Por eso Dios lo levantó sobre todo, y le concedió, el "Nombre-sobre-todonombre"; Aquí se arrodilla. de modo que al nombre de Jesús toda rodilla se doble —en el Cielo, en la Tierra, en el Abismo—, y toda lengua proclame: "¡ Jesucristo es Señor!", para gloria de Dios Padre.

NOTE FROM THE ASSISTANT PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR ASISTENTE

We commence the most important week for Christendom the Sacred Triduum, in which we celebrate the events of salvation history. Holy Week starts with the reading of the different accounts of the Passion of the Lord which summarize the events that lead to the Resurrection of the Lord, the most important event which is the foundation of Our faith. Our Lord promised that whoever believes in Him shall live forever. Our Lord said that He is the Resurrection and the life, and opened for us the gates of Heaven. Palm Sunday begins with the opening and singing to the Messiah, welcoming Him with Palms; however, this is just the beginning according to the abbot Dom Gueranger, "This ceremony is intended to represent the entry of Jesus into that Jerusalem of which the earthly one was but the figure - the Jerusalem of heaven, which has been opened for us by our Saviour. The sin of our first parents had shut it against us; but Jesus, the King of glory, opened its gates by His cross, to which every resistance yields. Let us, then, continue to follow in the footsteps of the Son of David, for He is also the Son of God, and He invites us to share His kingdom with Him. Thus, by the procession, which is commemorative of what happened on this day, the Church raises up our thoughts to the glorious mystery of the Ascension, whereby heaven was made the close of Jesus' mission on earth. Alas! the interval between these two triumphs of our Redeemer are not all days of joy; and no sooner is our procession over, than the Church, who had laid aside for a moment the weight of her grief, falls back into sorrow and mourning". Are we going to remain indifferent to the main mysteries of our Salvation? Our God is a living God and is expecting us to attend the beautiful solemn ceremonies of Holy Week. Do not be indifferent to God who has loved us unto the end.

Damos comienzo a la semana más importante para la cristiandad con el Triduo Sagrado, en el que celebramos los acontecimientos de la historia de la salvación. La Semana Santa comienza con la lectura de los diferentes relatos de la Pasión del Señor que resumen los acontecimientos que conducen a la Resurrección del Señor, el acontecimiento más importante que es el fundamento de Nuestra fe porque Nuestro Señor prometió que todo aquel que en Él cree vivirá para siempre. Nuestro Señor dijo que Él es la Resurrección y la vida, y nos abrió las puertas del Cielo. El Domingo de Ramos comienza con la apertura y canto al Mesías, acogiéndolo con Palmas; sin embargo, esto es sólo el comienzo según el abad Dom Gueranger, "Esta ceremonia pretende representar la entrada de Jesús en esa Jerusalén de la que la terrenal no era más que la figura, la Jerusalén del cielo, que nos ha sido abierta por nuestro Salvador, el pecado de nuestros primeros padres la había cerrado contra nosotros, pero Jesús, el Rey de la gloria, abrió sus puertas por su cruz, ante la cual toda resistencia cede, sigamos, pues, en las huellas del Hijo de David, porque Él es también el Hijo de Dios, y nos invita a compartir Su reino con Él. Así, mediante la procesión, que es conmemorativa de lo acontecido en este día, la Iglesia eleva nuestro pensamiento al misterio glorioso de la Ascensión, por la cual se hizo el cielo el fin de la misión de Jesús en la tierra. ¡Ay!, el intervalo entre estos dos triunfos de nuestro Redentor no son todos días de alegría; y tan pronto como termina nuestra procesión, la Iglesia, que había dejado a un lado por un momento el peso de su pena, vuelve a caer en dolor y luto". ¿Vamos a permanecer indiferentes ante los principales misterios de nuestra Salvación? Nuestro Dios es un Dios vivo que está esperando que vengamos y asistamos a las hermosas ceremonias solemnes de la Semana Santa. No seáis indiferentes a Dios que nos ha amado hasta el final.
