And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed with a white robe, and they were astonished. Who saith to them: Be not affrighted; ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified: He is risen, He is not here; behold the place where they laid Him. But go, tell His disciples, and Peter, that He goeth before you into Galilee: there you shall see Him, as He told you.

## COLECTA

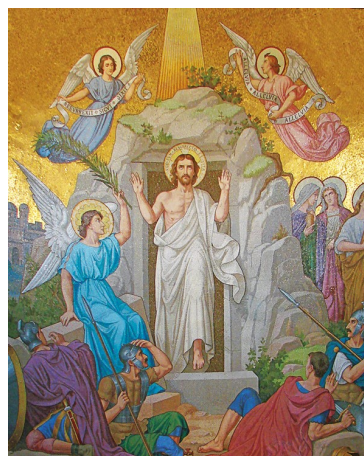

## NOTE FROM THE ASSISTANT PASTOR / NOTA DEL PASTOR ASISTENTE

The greatest of feast days is today, Easter Sunday! Today, there is no room for sadness nor worry. Today our Savior works His greatest miracle and gives us hope, that we too can rise from the death of mortal sin to a new life of heavenly glory. To add to your joy this Easter morning, read the words of St. Vincent Ferrer as he explains what it was like for Mary, His mother on that Easter morning: "The Virgin Mary was most certain that her son would rise on the third day, as he had predicted, but perhaps she did not know the hour of his resurrection, whether at prime or terce [first or third hour of daylight]. Nonetheless, she prepared the room, and found a chair for her son, saying, 'Here my son shall sit and here I will speak with him.' And she looked out the window, and she saw the dawn breaking, and she rejoiced, saying, 'Now my son is rising.'" Happy Easter from the Priests and staff of Mater Misericordiae Parish.

Para agregarle alegría a esta mañana de Pascua, leamos las palabras de san Vicente Ferrer donde explica cómo fue para María, la Madre de Dios, aquella mañana de Pascua: La Virgen María tenía la certeza de que su hijo resucitaría al tercer día, tal como lo predijo, aunque tal vez no sabía si su resurrección sería a la hora prima o tercia (la primera o la tercera hora de luz del día). Sin embargo, preparó el cuarto y puso una silla para su hijo diciendo: «Aquí se sentará mi hijo y aquí hablaré con él». Miró por la ventana y vio el amanecer; se regocijó y dijo: «Mi hijo está resucitando». ¡Los sacerdotes y el personal de la parroquia de Mater Misericordiae les deseamos felices Pascuas!
