SUNDAY EPISTLE: Ephesians 5:1-9

Brethren: Be ye followers of God, as most dear children: and walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us and hath delivered Himself for us, an oblation and a sacrifice to God for an odor of sweetness. But fornication, and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not so much as be named among you, as becometh saints: or obscenity, or foolish talking, or scurrility, which is to no purpose: but rather giving of thanks. For know you this, and understand, that no fornicator, or unclean, or covetous person, which is a serving of idols, hath inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the anger of God upon the children of unbelief. Be ye not therefore partakers with them. For you were heretofore darkness: but now light in the Lord. Walk then as children of the light: for the fruit of the light is in all goodness and justice and truth.

SUNDAY GOSPEL: Luke 11:14-28

At that time Jesus was casting out a devil, and the same was dumb. And when He had cast out the devil, the dumb spoke, and the multitudes were in admiration at it. But some of them said: He casteth out devils by Beelzebub, the prince of devils. And others, tempting, asked of Him a sign from heaven. But He, seeing their thoughts said to them: Every kingdom divided against itself shall be brought to desolation, and house upon house shall fall. And if Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because you say that through Beelzebub I cast out devils. Now if I cast out devils by Beelzebub, by whom do your children cast them out? Therefore, they shall be your judges. But if I by the finger of God cast out devils; doubtless the kingdom of God is come upon you. When a strong man armed keepeth his court, those things are in peace which he possesseth. But if a stronger than he is come upon him and overcome him, he will take away all his armor wherein he trusted, and will distribute his spoils. He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth. When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through places without water, seeking rest: and not finding, he saith: I will return into my house whence I came out. And when he is come, he findeth it swept and garnished. Then he goeth and taketh with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and entering in they dwell there. And the last state of that man becomes worse than the first. And it came to pass, as He spoke these things, a certain woman from the crowd, lifting up her voice, said to Him: Blessed is the womb that bore Thee and the paps that gave Thee suck. But He said: Yea, rather, blessed are they who hear the word of God, and keep it.

◆ **From the Pastor:** I would like to take a moment to assure everyone that I am staying in touch with the Diocese, FSSP Superiors and local doctors in regards to the covid 19 virus. At the moment there are no directives to change how Holy Communion is received. However, I would like to encourage everyone to take measures to stay healthy, such as frequent handwashing. Now more than ever, please stay home if you are sick. It is not mortal sin to stay home if you are sick. It is imprudent and possibly sinful to come to Mass sick and risk getting others sick as well. On a separate note, I would like to remind everyone that I do not solicit money in the form of gift cards either via email or texting. ◆ **Maudy Thursday Adoration:** All night adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is scheduled for Thursday, April 9 from 9:00pm to 9:00am in the church hall. We need adorers to cover these hours. The sign up binder is located on the vestibule table. There will be security available to walk you to your car when your adoration time is completed.

◆ **Compline:** You are invited to sing Compline with the priests every Friday of Lent after the 6:30pm Mass (except First Fridays).

◆ **Basket Blessings:** Father will bless your baskets of bread and eggs after all the Easter Masses, starting with the Easter Vigil Mass. You may keep the baskets in the hall as not to crowd the pews.

◆ **40 Days for Life:** This is a nationwide campaign of prayer and fasting to end abortion. This year's fall campaign ends April 5.
