SUNDAY EPISTLE: 1 Cor. 10:6-13

Brethren, let us not covet evil things, as they also coveted. Neither become ye idolaters, as some of them, as it is written: The people sat down to eat and drink and rose up to play. Neither let us commit fornication, as some of them committed fornication, and there fell in one day three and twenty thousand. Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them tempted, and perished by the serpents. Neither do you murmur, as some of them murmured, and were destroyed by the destroyer. Now all these things happened to them in figure, and they are written for our correction, upon whom the ends of the world are come. Wherefore, he that thinketh himself to stand, let him take heed lest he fall. Let no temptation take hold on you, but such as is human; and God is faithful, Who will not suffer you to be tempted above that which you are able, but will make also with temptation issue, that you may be able to bear it.

SUNDAY GOSPEL: Lk. 19:41-47

At that time, when Jesus drew near to Jerusalem, seeing the city, He wept over it, saying: If thou also hadst known, and that in this thy day, the things that are to thy peace: but now they are hidden from thine eyes. For the days shall come upon thee, and thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and straiten thee on every side; and beat thee flat to the ground, and thy children who are in thee; and they shall not leave in thee a stone upon a stone, because thou hast not known the time of thy visitation. And entering into the temple, He began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought, saying to them: It is written: My house is the house of prayer, but you have made it a den of thieves. And He was teaching daily in the temple.

Maryann has been married for 38 years, she and her husband have a daughter, son, and daughter-in-law with two beautiful grandbabies. During her family's 23 years of living in Arizona, Maryann has volunteered and worked for several parishes within the Diocese of Phoenix. She has worked for Our Lord developing and building programs for RCIC, RCIA, and Adult Faith Formation. She also created a Catholic Vacation Bible School program based upon the approved apparitions of Our Blessed Mother to whom she is deeply devoted. By God's grace, Maryann's love for Our Lady has drawn her deeply to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel as a lay OCDS Carmelite.

Maryann began her studies in theology in New York after majoring in philosophy in college. Her work for the Church was for the parish of Holy Name of Jesus, where she ran RE and VBS for many years. Since living in Phoenix, Maryann completed Kino Institute, Prepare the Way, theology studies, and has also become certified in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. The last seven years she has worked for St. Paul Catholic Church as DRE. She also created programs for adult faith formation, including Faith Study classes, RCIA, spirituality and devotions. Maryann has felt honored to sit on the Friends of the Cathedral Board for Bishop Olmsted organizing Eucharistic Missions for the Diocese. She has brought and organized the Treasures of the Church Vatican Relic Tour in the Diocese, as well as the famous Blue Army Fatima Statue, before which Padre Pio himself prayed. Since the early 2000's, Maryann has worked with different teams to begin perpetual Adoration chapels in the Diocese and led the opening of the St. Paul Perpetual Adoration Chapel in 2016.
